



Global markets demand multilingualism and localization



Technical Communication

The term encompasses the management of all important information over the life cycle of a product. This includes all internal information and metainformation relating to internal processes and workflows as well as the resulting company knowledge. The Noxum Publishing Studio offers you process support and allows information management and cross media publishing for technical communication purposes.

Web Systems/Web Portals/E-Business

The World Wide Web has become an important place of business. E-commerce, paid content and e-payment solutions have long been a standard, essential part of the web content management market. Web portals should aim to address both global markets and markets which focus on particular target groups. However, they should also offer online functions which are tailored precisely to particular target groups. What is more, they must meet these requirements whilst satisfying the fundamental need for security and performance. The Noxum Publishing Studio helps you to compile your information for the Internet, Intranet and Extranet and to integrate this information on a single platform. The result is a coherent overall image across all markets.

Product Information Management

Shortened product life cycles and increasing product diversification present considerable challenges when it comes to managing product information. This information is produced as a result of product development, construction, product marketing and sales activities, and some of it is stored in databases and merchandise management systems. This is exactly where the Noxum Publishing Studio comes in. It obtains existing data from the various external systems and adds any other data which may be necessary. The system provides the option of classifying the information according to established market standards, e.g. ETIM or eCl@ss, and offers additional benefits thanks to its cross media publishing capabilities. Standard exchange formats, e.g. BMEcat, can also be generated.

Cross Media Publishing

Gone are the days when documents were published only in printed form. Nowadays, documents must be made available via a number of different channels. Although the challenges involved in publishing documents via the Intranet/Internet, producing PDF or CD-ROM documentation or preparing the documents for use on mobile devices are by no means insurmountable, it is difficult to cope with the sheer variety of different media. The Noxum Publishing Studio was designed to do just that. It is based upon a coherent concept and outstanding technologies. An intuitive user interface makes it easy to find existing information modules. The user can structure this information in a hierarchical fashion, add additional information if necessary, and then generate the desired output formats.

Innovative software design at its best

A good house is built on solid foundations

The Noxum Publishing Studio is based upon Microsoft® .NET technology. This technology supports the "best of breed" principle. This means for example that a professional XML editor which offers the ease of use and functions required by the user can be seamlessly integrated into the user interface. Microsoft® SQL Server or Oracle® Database are used as databases. These technologies are tried and tested and form the basis for the application's high-performance design.

Decentralized access to centralized resources

The Noxum Publishing Studio is based upon a client/server architecture. The client software provides the user with convenient access to the functions on the server which stores and manages all data centrally in the form of information objects. The Noxum Publishing Studio offers client interfaces which are tailored to a specific editorial team.

Modularity - the key to genuine Cross Media Publishing

The software and content building blocks are highly modularized. This makes cross media publishing and single source publishing possible for the first time. The Noxum Publishing Studio sets new standards by closely integrating all functions – from capturing documents and managing content to publishing documents via a range of different channels.

Future proof thanks to international standards

The consistent use of XML allows structure, content and layout to be clearly segregated. We rely on international standards such as XML, XSL-T, XSLFO, XHTML, XPath, XQuery, SOAP or DTDs and XML schemas. These are developed further by the W3C Consortium. Our product information management systems use established classification standards such as ETIM or eCl@ss as well as conventional exchange formats such as BMEcat.

Tested and certified

Renowned customers enlist independent firms or institutions (e.g. Integralis or IBS) to test our software solutions. In the process, our systems undergo complex load, security and penetration tests as well as web accessibility checks. We pass these tests on a regular basis.

In 2005, the Noxum Publishing Studio was also certified for use on Microsoft platforms by the Veritest certification institute.
