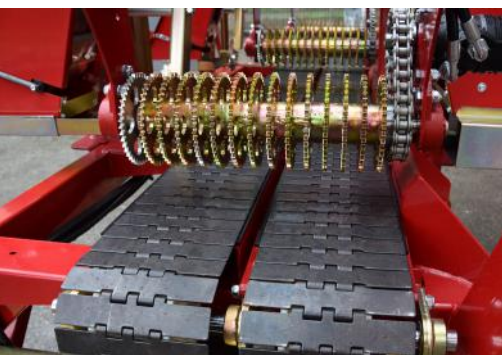
MK 402 to MK 405 Resaw with the thinnest cutting kerf

Depending on the number of desired sawheads

The multi-head sawmill from SERRA is used as a resaw for boards and slats. The benefit against a circular resaw is, that the cutting kerf is much thinner. Because of that less precious wood will be transformed into sawdust, furthermore the power requirement is lower. In contrast to the main sawmill not the sawhead is moving back and forth along the log. Instead of that, the sawhead is static and the lumber gets pushed through.
